INDEMNIFICATION AND WAIVER OF DAMAGES

Applicant shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the City, its elected and appointed officials, agents, employees, representatives, and volunteers from and against any and all claims and actions, demands, damages, civil penalties, charges, judgments, losses, liabilities of any character or kind and other legal actions and proceedings of whatever nature, including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees and litigation expenses (including without limitation fees to establish the right to indemnification) resulting from, arising out of, related to, or caused by Applicant's conduct of business or from any activity or other things done, permitted, or suffered by Applicant in or about the Premises and/or Airport or other act or failure to act, excluding only claims or actions arising out of the sole negligence of the City, its elected and appointed officials, agents and employees, provided that the City shall give Applicant prompt and reasonable notice of any such claim or actions made or filed against it.

Applicant hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the City, its elected and appointed officials, agents and employees, from any damages to Applicant caused by noise, vibrations, fumes, dust, fuel particles and all other effects that may be caused by the operation of aircraft landing at or taking off from, or operating at or on the Airport; and Applicant does hereby fully waive, remise and release any right or cause of action which it may now have or which it may have in the future against the City, its successors and assigns, due to such noise, vibrations, fumes, dust, fuel particles, and all other effects that may be caused or may have been caused by the operation at or on the Airport. The above exception shall not limit a cause of action against other persons or entities, including without limitation licensees, concessionaires, or aircraft operators.
