

CITY OF REDMOND DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) PROGRAM
POLICY STATEMENT

Section 26.1, 26.23 Objectives/Policy Statement

The **City of Redmond** has established a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program for **Redmond Municipal Airport** in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 26. The **City of Redmond** has received Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation, and as a condition of receiving this assistance, the **City of Redmond** has signed an assurance that it will comply with 49 CFR Part 26.

It is the policy of the **City of Redmond** to ensure that DBEs as defined in Part 26, have an equal opportunity to receive and participate in DOT-assisted contracts. It is also our policy:

1. To ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of DOT – assisted contracts;
2. To create a level playing field on which DBEs can compete fairly for DOT-assisted contracts;
3. To ensure that the DBE Program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law;
4. To ensure that only firms that fully meet 49 CFR Part 26 eligibility standards are permitted to participate as DBEs;
5. To help remove barriers to the participation of DBEs in DOT assisted contracts;
6. To assist the development of firms that can compete successfully in the market place outside the DBE Program.

Implementation of the DBE program is accorded the same priority as compliance with all other legal obligations incurred by the **City of Redmond** in its financial assistance agreements with the Department of Transportation.


The **City of Redmond** has distributed this statement to City Council and all of the components of our organization that have duties and responsibilities associated with the **Redmond Municipal Airport**. The **City of Redmond** will provide printed or disk copies of the DBE program upon request. Following approval of the DBE program the Objective/Policy Statement portion of the program will be distributed to DBE and non-DBE business communities that perform work for us on DOT-assisted contracts in all bid documents.




